Suggested supply list.

Go shopping at www.DickBlick.com or another on-line art supply store or go to Hobby Lobby or rummage through your own old art supplies.

Bring to class:

A smallish sketchbook, maybe 8x10 or something.

Bring a larger pad of drawing paper, at least 11x14 or larger. Be sure the pad says Drawing Paper and 80lb weight. If we need more paper I'll have some loose drawing sheets for sale so you can experiment with papers.

Kneaded eraser

Magic rub eraser

6B pencils and softer, like 7B or 8B

Pencil sharpener or sand paper sharpener.

An assortment of soft drawing sticks.

Like Conte Crayons, Compressed Pastel Chalk, Charcoal sticks, Graphite sticks or whatever else looks interesting to you. Please keep the colors earth colors or blacks and grays.
